

2008 Arab Science Journalism Award

The Arab Science & Technology Foundation and the Arab Science Journalists Association announce their first annual Arab Science Journalism Award.

The winner in each category will receive a monetary award and a certificate of journalism excellence from the Arab Science & Technology Foundation and the Arab Science Journalists Association. Winners will also be invited, all-expenses paid, to attend the 1st Arab Conference for Science Journalists and the Scientific Research Outlook Symposium V, which will both be held in Fez, Morocco, in October 2008.

The award consists of the following categories:

1. **Print and online media award (Arabic): 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes.** 1st prize will receive \$1000, 2nd prize will receive \$750 and 3rd prize will receive \$500.
2. **Print and online media award (French): \$1000**
3. **Print and online media award (English): \$1000**

Criteria

Journalists from all over the world covering Arab science, technology, health, or environmental issues can participate and submit their articles for the appropriate award category.

Only one article can be submitted per individual.

If the submitted work has had any clear impact on policy-making, society, the scientific system, etc. this should be mentioned in a short cover letter accompanying the submission.

Deadline for submission: July 15, 2008

Please make sure to include in your submission the following:

- Original and three photocopies of your article in case of print
- Three copies of your online article including the URL of the original online article in case of an online submission
- Your CV, including your contact information (email, mailing address, phones, and fax)

Announcement of winners will be made in August 2008.

Submissions should be for the period between July 15, 2006 and July 15, 2008 (a period of two years). Submissions dating before this will not be accepted. All submissions must be of published material. Only one submission is allowed per person.

Winners who cannot make it to the award ceremony will not be compensated and will receive their financial award of \$1000 and certificate by transfer/mail.
